Nurse Practitioners in orthopedics care for patients in the hospital in trauma units, surgical units, the operating room and outpatient clinics.

Nurse Practitioners in orthopedics work with physicians, nurses, pharmacists, physiotherapists, occupational therapists, and community providers to care for patients undergoing joint replacement, during and following a fracture, to optimize muscle and bone movement and function.

Nurse Practitioners in orthopedics participate in research and provide education to promote muscle and bone health across the life span.
